MOTION OF THE MOUSAM AND KENNEBUNK RIVERS ALLIANCE TO INTERVENE IN THE
KENNEBUNK LIGHT AND POWER DISTRICT SURRENDER PROCEEDINGS, P-5362-021

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. 385.214(d) of the Rules of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”), and the Commission’s Notice of April 21, 2021 (Accession # 2110421-3190), the Mousam and Kennebunk Rivers Alliance (“MKRA”) moves to intervene in the above captioned proceeding.

INTEREST OF MOVANTS:

MKRA is an unincorporated alliance founded in 2008 to improve the ecological health of the Mousam and Kennebunk River watersheds – from the headwaters to the ocean – for fish, birds, wildlife, and people. The MKRA has been focused on monitoring and improving water quality; restoring and enhancing native fisheries; and encouraging people to appreciate and experience the uniqueness and vitality of their local rivers. MKRA projects have included documenting the presence of native diadromous fish species, surveying road-stream crossings, and holding conferences, workshops, and educational events on an array of diverse topics related to the Mousam and Kennebunk Rivers. MKRA has also been actively engaged with KLPD, the Town of Kennebunk, and the local citizenry in the vigorous discussion regarding the disposition of the dams and the fate of the Mousam River over the past several years.

Most of the members of MKRA are residents of the local community and reside near the Project area, some of whom own land abutting the impoundments created by the KLPD dams. These members actively recreate on the Mousam River and surrounding conservation lands and/or have long been involved in education, advocacy, conservation and restoration efforts on the Mousam River and its watershed.

POSITION OF MKRA

MKRA opposes the application for an order surrendering the license with the dams in place and will join the joint comments to be submitted prior to the due date by the Mousam River Coalition.
