Dear Secretary Bose:

On April 21, 2021, the Commission issued a *Notice of Application for Surrender of License, Soliciting Comments, Motions to Intervene, and Protests* in response to the Surrender Application the Lower Mousam Hydroelectric Project (Project No. 5362-021) on the Mousam River in York County, Maine. By this letter we provide notice pursuant to 18 C.F.R. §385.214(a), as amended, that our Agency is requesting intervenor status in this proceeding. Under Maine State Law (12 MRSA, §6021), the Maine Department of Marine Resources (MDMR) mandate is "...conserve and develop marine and estuarine resources; to conduct and sponsor scientific research; to promote and develop the Maine coastal fishing industries; to advise and cooperate with local, state and federal officials concerning activities in coastal waters; and to implement, administer and enforce the laws and regulations necessary for these enumerated purposes, as well as the exercise of all authority conferred by this Part." Intervenor status will provide opportunity for participation.
